

PROCEDURE FOR APPEALING A DENIAL

If your request for information is denied, or partially denied, you have the right to request a review by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Illinois Attorney General's Office within 60 days of the date on the denial letter per 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). To file an appeal, you must send a letter—along with a copy of your request and denial letter—to the following address:

FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DATE OF MAY 2024 AND
ENDING ON THE THIRTIETH DAY OF APRIL 2025

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the Manhattan Park District, Will County, ILLINOIS.

It is hereby found and determined that:

- a) The Board of Park Commissioners of the Manhattan Park District, Will County, Illinois caused to be prepared in tentative form a combined Budget and Appropriation Ordinance and the Secretary of this Board has made the same conveniently available to public inspection for at least thirty days prior to final action, thereon, and
- b) A public hearing was held as to such Budget and Appropriation Ordinance at the Village of Manhattan Meeting Room, Manhattan, Illinois on the 13th day of June 2024 and notice of said hearing was given at least one (1) week prior thereto as required by law by publication in the Joliet Herald News, a newspaper published within the Park District; and
- c) That all other legal requirements have been complied with for the adoption of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of the Park District for the fiscal year beginning on the first day of May 2024 and ending on the thirtieth day of April 2025.

SECTION I. The following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law for the following objects and purposes, be and the same are hereby budgeted and appropriated for the fiscal year beginning the first day of May 2024 and ending on the thirtieth day of April 2025.

Each of said sums of money and the aggregate thereof is deemed necessary by this Board to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the District during the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2024, and ending April 30, 2025, for the respective purposes set forth.

All unexpended balances of the appropriations for the fiscal year ended April 30, 2025 and prior years are hereby specifically re-appropriated for the same general purposes for which they were originally made and may be expended in making up any insufficiency of any other items provided in this appropriation ordinance, in making this appropriation in accordance with applicable law.

SECTION III. The following determinations have been made and are hereby made a part of the aforesaid budget:

- a) An estimate of the cash on hand at the beginning of the fiscal year is expected to be \$ 1,120,320.00
- b) An estimate of the cash expected to be received during the fiscal year from all sources is \$ 2,694,532.00
- d) An estimate of the expenditures contemplated for the fiscal year is \$ 2,894,896.00
- d) An estimate of the cash expected to be on hand at the end of the fiscal year is \$ 919,956.00
- e) An estimate of the amount of taxes to be received during the fiscal year is \$ 1,802,399.00

SECTION IV. The receipts and revenues of the Manhattan Park District derived from sources other than taxation and not specifically appropriated, and all unexpended balances from the preceding fiscal year not required for the purposes for which they were appropriated and levied, shall constitute the General Fund and shall first be placed to the credit of such fund.

SECTION V. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby, repealed to the extent of such conflict. If any item or portion thereof of this Budget and Appropriation Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity for the remaining portion of such items or the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION VI. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
